Biography: Professor Jiansheng Dai is the Director of Institute of Robotics, Southern University of Science and Technology, China, and Honorary Chair Professor of King's College London, UK. He received BEng and MSc in 1982 and 1984 from Shanghai Jiao Tong University, China, and PhD in 1993 from University of Salford, UK. Professor Dai is a Fellow of the Royal Academy of Engineering (FREng), Academia Europaea of Sciences Fellow, IEEE Fellow, ASME Fellow, IMechE Fellow and RSA Fellow. He is the Editor-in-Chief of international journal Robotica and a Subject Editor of Mechanism and Machine Theory. He has published over 700 peer-reviewed papers and 9 authored books with Google scholar h-index of 72, and graduated over 50 PhD students who are currently either faculty members of world-leading universities, affiliated with prestigious corporations, or successful entrepreneurs. Professor Dai is the recipient of ASME DED Mechanisms and Robotics Award in 2015, ASME Machine Design Award in 2020, IFToMM Award of Merits in 2023, AT Yang Award in Theoretical Kinematics in 2019, Crossley Award in 2018, and King's College London Overall Supervisory Excellence Award in 2010.
